LOVE AND JUSTICE

Proverbs 15:10 ... "Harsh discipline is for him who forsakes the way; and he who hates correction will die."

One of the hardest ideas for man to accept about God, is that he is a loving God who also delivers justice and punishment. I cannot count the number of times I have heard people say that because he is a God of love, he cannot condemn people to hell, punish wrong doers, or inflict his enemies with violence. Plus, children observe their parent's rejection of God and conclude that they should, too. This produces an increase in disrespect for parents and the church, juvenile crime, drug use, and immorality among the young. Sadly, too many people today fail to understand the character of God, and that raising Godly children produces good character in both us and our children, and good character avoids God's justice.

The earth is not a blank canvass that we can create or destroy as we please, behave as we please, and not suffer consequences for our bad behavior. The earth is God's property; he created it and his rules must be followed to avoid harsh discipline. You are God's property; he created you and his instructions must be followed to avoid harsh discipline. When you respect and honor God with your life, you will enjoy an abundance of his love, protection, provision, and blessings. When you reject the One true God and create your own god, you are on your own and will eventually suffer from your disobedience. God is both loving and just; pick for yourself the attribute you prefer to enjoy.
